The metal ashtray measuring 4" X 6" is one of many souvenir items produced related to Michigan's Keweenaw Peninsula Copper County mining industry. The

four scenes depict (clockwise from upper left); 1) five million pounds of ingot copper ready for shipping at the Houghton docks; 2) the Michigan College of Mines in Houghton; 3) a

man-car full of miners ascending from the depths of a copper mine, this item is circa 1930's; 4) the Quincy Mine Shaft House No. 1 on Quincy Hill above Hancock.
