




Tobacco Tin-Lunch Bucket

This tobacco tin was produced to be used by the buyer as a lunch bucket after the tobacco had been used. It features four mining vignettes - a lunch bucket, tobacco pouch and clay pipe, an oilwick lamp, a coal car and a crossed pick and shovel.



Souvenir Plate

This souvenir plate depicts the Calumet & Hecla Red Jacket Shaft at Calumet, Michigan. The Red Jacket Shaft was one of the few shafts operated by C & H that was vertical, most shafts were inclined. The main hoistenginehouse contained two pair of triple expansion engines rated at 3,000 hp per pair with a Whiting drum system capable of hoisting a tension load at a rate of 60' per second. The plate is marked "Hand Painted in Germany" on the back.
